

# Sony Play Station



## User Accounts Hacked !



On April 2011 the Sony user account database was hacked by criminals. All Sony Play Station users who have their system connected to the internet are now at a severe security risk.

The criminals have acquired user account names, home addresses, email addresses and birthdates. It is possible that they may also have acquired login passwords and credit card details.

With this stolen information, the criminals may now contact users in various ways to scam them ~ attempting to get further access to more personal details including their bank accounts.

## Critical Steps to protect yourself :

- Change passwords on any Credit cards used to create the Sony play station user account or on-line purchases
- Do not respond to fake emails from Sony
- Do not respond to fake telephone calls from Sony
- Do not respond to fake posted letters from Sony

If you are contacted legitimately from Sony about this issue, they will not be asking you for any personal details.

Anyone asking you for personal details concerning this issue will likely be criminals attempting to scam you.

The stolen information may also be traded to other criminals in further attempts to scam you via your home computer.
